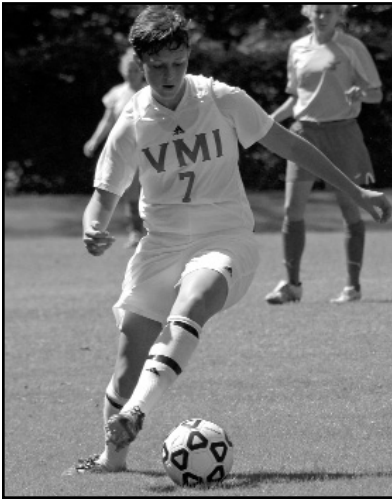


#7 Chrissy Beach

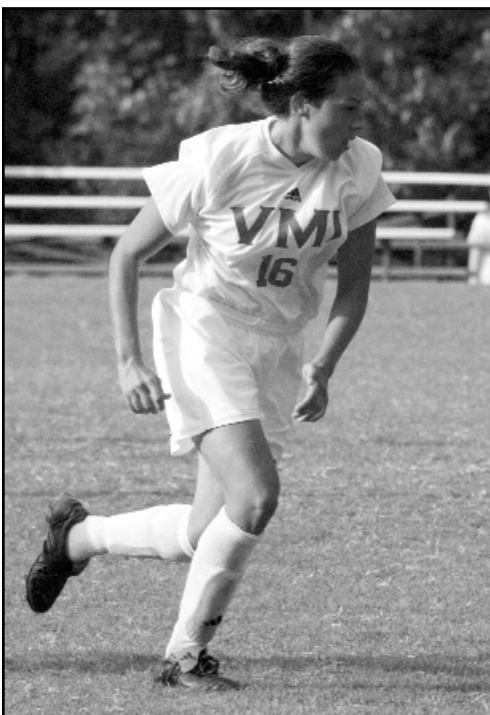

THREE-YEAR LETTERWINNER- Team Co-Captain with classmate and fellow Atlee HS alum Erin Squires...Versatile and tenacious player that could see action in a number of roles this season...Could contend for All-Conference honors this season...Already ranks second in career goals and points while holding the school records for assists (tied) and game-winning goals...Ranks as an S-6 Lieutenant in the VMI Corps of Cadets.

2006: Saw action in all 17 contests, making 15 starts...Ranked second on the team with six goals, while placing third on the squad with 13 points...Led VMI with 22 shots...Had a pair of two-goal games, scoring twice against Southern Virginia (10/10) and South Carolina State (10/22), both wins... Scored the game-winner in a 2-0 victory over The Citadel (9/1), VMI's first win over the Bulldogs...Converted first career penalty kick against The Citadel.



2005: Had a breakout season on the attack, setting new school records with 15 goals, six assists, 36 points and five game-winners...Established numerous single-match records against West Virginia Tech by scoring four goals, three assists and 11 points...Also collected a hat trick by scoring three goals against Southern Virginia... Scored the game-winner in the Keydets' first victory over a Division I opponent, defeating Youngstown State on 9/11...Also scored the game-winner in a 4-2 win over High Point, the team's first Big South Conference victory...Scored a point in four consecutive games, tying a school record.

2004: Tallied her first collegiate goal against Alabama A&M on 10/10 (unassisted)... Ranked second on the team with 22 shots, half of which came on goal...Started every contest at forward.

High School: Lettered four years at Atlee High School...Played in the midfield as a freshman and sophomore, earning academic all-district honors and scoring four goals in each of those years... Moved to forward and scored 11 goals in her junior season and 24 goals as a senior... ONE-YEAR LETTERWINNER- Very skilled player that saw success as an outside midfielder and as a forward as a freshman, but is expected to move inside this season...Has tremendous foot skills and quickness as well as a strong work ethic...Started every game as a freshman, becoming one of only ten players in school history to do so...Could contend for All-Conference honors this season...Ranks as a Corporal in the VMI Corps of Cadets

2006: Named **Big South Conference Freshman of the Year** after ranking second among League rookies with 15 points...One of three Keydets to start every contest, and one of two freshmen to do so, along with Jessica Robbins...

Set a school record for assists by a freshman, while her goals and points totals were the second-most by a VMI freshman...Led the Keydets in points in Conference play...Scored first career goal against Delaware State (9/17)...Saw 15 of her 22 shots go on goal, leading the team with a .682 shots-on-goal percentage and a .227 shot percentage...

Picked up her first multi-goal game against Southern Virginia (10/10)... Scored a point in four of team's eight Big South contests...Also scored a point in the team's final four games, tying a school record...Selected as Distinguished in Academic Merit.

THREE-YEAR LETTERWINNER- Team Co-Captain with classmate and fellow Atlee HS alum Alexa Bernas...Tenacious player that saw time as an outside midfielder and as a forward last season...Has proved valuable in the possession game and in helping create attacks...Has appeared in every game since coming on post and is on pace to break the school marks for career games played and games started.

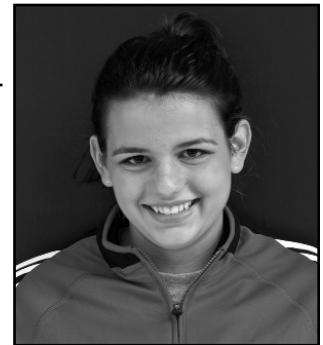

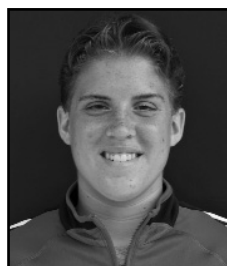
