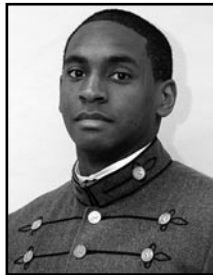

**2004** - Named first team All-Big South at receiver...Tied school mark for most catches in a game with 10 against Ohio in the season opener...earned coaches' offensive player award for Ohio, James Madison, and Liberty games...Posted his second consecutive 500-yard season in receiving and led the team with 57 catches for 595 yards and five touchdowns...extended his consecutive games reception streak to a school-tying 23 games...top games included 10 catches for 100 yards and two TD's vs. Ohio, nine catches for 114 yards and one touchdown against James Madison, and 10 catches for 84 yards and a touchdown against Liberty...had a 49-yard touchdown reception vs. Gardner-Webb... was ranked third in the league in receptions/game (5.18).
