2008: Enjoyed a fine season as a redshirt sophomore... Went 2-0 in 15 relief appearances, totaling a 1.64 ERA in 22.0 innings... Struck out 19 batters while walking only five... Allowed only two extra-base hits while facing 94 batters... Earned his first collegiate win against Norfolk State (3/19), entering the sixth inning with the go-ahead run at third base and working 1.1 scoreless innings... Made back-to-back appearances against Maryland-Eastern Shore (5/10 & 11), collecting a win in game three by allowing one base runner in 3.1 innings... Pitched 2.1 innings of scoreless relief in game three against Lafayette (2/24), allowing four hits while striking out two in an 11-9 loss... Made his first career start in game two at Auburn (3/7), going 0-for-4 as the DH before entering the game in relief on the mound, allowing one hit and nothing else in a 6-4 loss... Also appeared in five games offensively, including one start at designated hitter... Scored after a pinch-hit triple late in game one at Auburn (3/6).

Summer: Competed for the Petersburg Generals of the Coastal Plain League... Ranked second on the team with 15 appearances... Posted 27 strikeouts and only three walks in 39 innings... Went 2-2... Also hit .259 with three doubles in nine games.

2007: Took a medical redshirt as he recovered from off-season surgery.

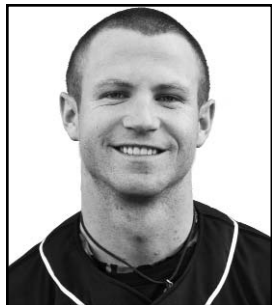

2008: Enjoyed a fine junior season, going 5-4 with a team-best 3.16 ERA...Led the Big South with only seven walks issued...In conference play, was 3-2 with a 3.41 ERA, striking out 33 while walking only four...Missed the final six weeks of the season after an injury on April 18, when he started on Friday night against Liberty...Defeated UNCA (4/12) by throwing seven innings, scattering five hits while allowing three runs, two earned...Picked up the win against Radford (4/6), starting game two of the series and allowing four runs on eight hits...Struck out a career-best 11 batters without issuing a walk in a loss against Winthrop (3/30), allowing four runs, only two earned...Named Big South Conference Pitcher of the Week after striking out a then-career-best ten while throwing seven innings of VMI's first shutout of the season, a 3-0 win over High Point (3/22)...Made two relief appearances before moving to the weekend rotation...In his first three appearances of the season, struck out 15 batters without issuing a walk...Pitched five innings in his start at Auburn (3/9), allowing four runs, two earned while striking out six...Threw his third career complete game against CCSU (3/2), allowing one earned run and striking out eight while not walking a batter...Allowed three hits and no runs in 3.2 innings, striking out seven in season debut against Lafayette (2/23).

2007: Moved into the weekend rotation after consecutive mid-week wins over Old Dominion (3/21), VCU (3/27) and #3 Virginia (4/3)...Hurled 8.1 innings of one-run ball against Old Dominion...Defeated VCU just a week later by surrendering only two runs in 5.2 innings while setting a career-high with seven strikeouts...Followed that up with a 7.2-inning outing against #3 Virginia, allowing only two runs while again striking out seven as the team defeated its highest-ranked opponent in program history...Tied for the second-most wins on the team...Surrendered only one hit against Coppin State (4/14) in five innings...Set a new career-best by pitching all nine innings against UNC Asheville (4/29), clinching a series win with a 5-3 win by scattering seven singles and allowing only two earned runs...Claimed the series-clinching win in game three over Radford (5/13), working into the eighth inning, allowing four runs, three earned to win his sixth decision of the season...Began season in the bullpen, enjoying his best outing at Florida (2/11), allowing no runs and one hit in 3.1 innings, striking out five.

2006: Began the year as a weekend starter before suffer-

ing a shoulder injury that sidelined him for six weeks...Came back as a member of the bullpen, where he excelled...Appeared in 12 games, making five starts...In his first career start, held Auburn scoreless for four innings (2/5), allowing only four hits while striking out three...On the season, struck out 18 batters while walking only nine...Keydets went 4-1 in his five starts.

Personal: Son of Colleen Tolson and David Henderson...Played for the Mid-Maryland Red Sox and Stafford American Legion Post 290...Won an AAU National Championship in 1999, also a member of the 2001 All-National team and Best In Virginia 2004...Majoring in psychology.

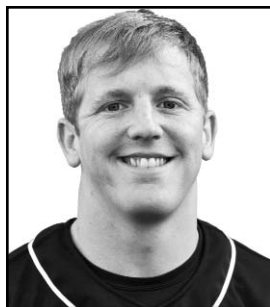

Local product that came up with big hits when needed last season...Will start in the outfield and hit in the middle of the order.

2008: Enjoyed a breakout season as a redshirt sophomore...Hit .320 with eight doubles, seven home runs and 39 RBIs while starting 46 games, with a majority of those coming in left field...Did most of his damage in Big South play, leading VMI with a .374 batting average, 34 hits, 18 RBIs, five home runs and a .582 slugging percentage...Ranked fourth in the Big South in league games in hits, seventh in total bases and ninth in batting average...Had a career-best 14-game hitting streak, during which he hit .412 (28-for-68) with four doubles, two home runs, 14 RBIs...Drove home the tying run in the ninth inning and scored the winning run in the 16th in VMI's 6-5, 16-inning win at Liberty (4/19)...Earned Big South Player of the Week honors on April 7, posting three multiple-hit games as VMI went 4-0 on the week, hitting .417 with eight RBIs...Set a new school record for at bats by going 4-for-8 in VMI's 16-inning, 3-2 win over Radford (4/7)...Also matched a school record with three doubles in that game...Hit a three-run, walk-off home run to give VMI a 4-3, 11-inning victory in game one against Radford (4/6)...Went 3-for-4 with two doubles and two runs scored in a 9-5 win over Richmond (4/1)...Posted his second four-hit game in a week by going 4-for-5 with two singles, a double and a home run, driving in three in a game three win over UNCA (4/13)...Tied the contest with a single in the fourth inning before giving the Keydets the lead with a solo home run in a 5-4 win against Winthrop (3/29)...Hit his first career grand slam and first for VMI in 2008 in the third inning against William & Mary (3/25)...In the doubleheader against High Point (3/22), went 5-for-8 with two RBI and a home run.

2007: A key contributor to the team down the stretch, leading all freshmen with a .293 average and 17 RBI while seeing action in 37 contests...In limited action, posted the third-highest slugging percentage on the team, and the highest among 2008 returners...Came up with a pinch-hit double in the 9th inning against Coastal Carolina in the Big South Championship (5/24)...Hit his third career HR to extend the lead in a 5-3 win over UNCA in game three (4/29), going 2-for-4 with two runs scored and nine putouts in CF...Hit his second home run of the season in game one against #20 Coastal Carolina (4/20), also collecting a double in the 7-5 loss...Saw his six-game hitting streak end in game two against High Point; during the run, he hit 10-for-22 (.455) with eight RBI, two 2B, 3B, and a HR...Collected RBI singles against #3 Virginia (4/3) and Virginia Tech (4/4), breaking up a no-

hitter in the fifth inning against the Hokies...In first three career starts, went 7-for-11 with five RBI against Savannah State, hitting .636, slugging 1.273 and reaching base at .692...Went 4-for-5 with three RBI, a double and a triple in game two against SSU (3/31), then went 2-for-4 with first career HR in game three (4/1)...Had an RBI double to deep center field in eighth inning of game one at Auburn (3/13) after entering game two innings earlier as a pinch runner...Entered game two against UMES (3/10) in seventh inning and collected first career hit, an RBI double to deep center field.
