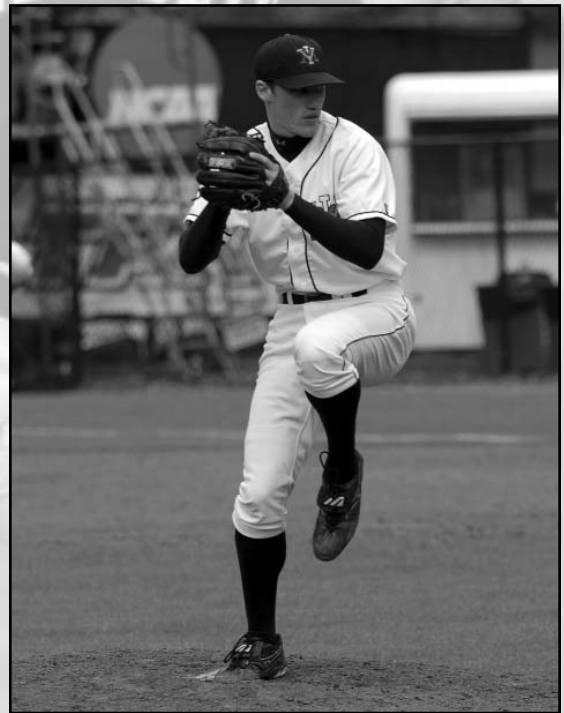

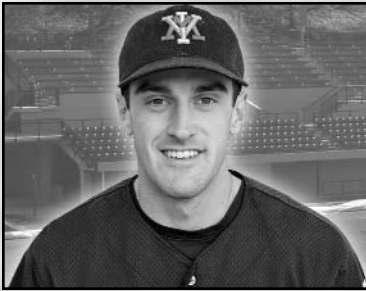

One of the best all-around players in the Big South, will start at first base and hit in the middle of the order.

2006: Hit well over .300 for the third-consecutive season, tying for the team with 41 RBI...Slugged .508 and posted a .436 on-base percentage, each second-best on the team, and collected a career-high 15 doubles and 40 runs...Blasted six home runs and his first career triple...Was hit by 18 pitches...Posted 18 multiple-hit games, including three three-hit games...Reached base in 46 of 52 games he played...Missed only three games due to ankle injury suffered on the second weekend of the season...Hit .322 with a .522 slugging percentage in Big South contests, driving in 20 runs in 24 games...Reached base in 22 of 24 League contests...Probably the top defensive first basemen in the Big South...His career .989 fielding percentage ranks him tops in VMI's history...Also ranks in the top ten in career batting average (.321) and on-base percentage (.410)...In a six-game span in mid-April, hit .429 (12-for-28) with eight RBI and 11 runs scored against High Point, Richmond & Radford.

Summer: Played in 53 of 55 contests, starting 49, while playing for the Outer Banks Daredevils of the Coastal Plain League for the second straight season...Ranked second on the team with 23 RBI and fourth on the team with 36 hits while hitting .202...Successful in four of five stolen base attempts...Made only four errors in 478 chances, good for a .992 fielding percentage.

2005: Had a breakout sophomore season that saw him rank in the top ten in the Big South in slugging percentage (.515) and home runs (10)...Led VMI with 43 RBI and ranked second on the team with a .319 batting average...Had 10 doubles and 39 runs scored...Put together the team's longest hitting streak of the season, reaching safely in 15 consecutive games (2/23-3/22)...Against Fairfield on March 7, went 4-for-5 with a double, 2 HR, 7 RBI and 4 runs scored...Went 4-for-4 vs. William & Mary (4/5) with a double, 2 HR and 4 RBI...Had an outstanding season in the field as well, leading the team with a .987 fielding percentage...Named Big South Player of the Week for week ending May 23.

Summer: Played with the Outer Banks Daredevils

of the Coastal Plain League... Started 49 contests...Second on the team with seven doubles...Also saw action on the mound in two games, collecting an ERA of 2.84 in 6.1 innings.

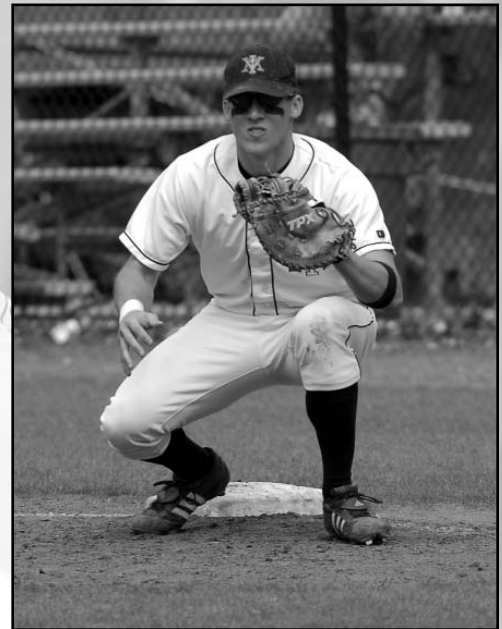

Expected to be the team's starting left fielder and to hit in the middle of the lineup and will see time at the back end of the bullpen.

2006: Ranked third on the team with a .327 batting average and 66 hits...One of two players to start every contest...Posted career highs in RBI (36), runs (43), slugging (.426), on-base percentage (.421) and walks (25)...Reached base in 49 of 55 contests, including 29 consecutive games over a two-month span...Earned Big South Player of the Week accolades when he hit an amazing 9-for-10 with two doubles, three RBI and five runs scored against #16 Winthrop, leading the Keydets to their first series win against a ranked opponent...Hit home runs in back-to-back games, combining to go 6-for-10 with seven RBI against High Point (4/9) and Richmond (4/12)...Led the team with a .341 batting average and .441 on-base percentage in Big South play...Also made 11 relief appearances on the mound, collecting four saves, including one in his first outing of the season, at Auburn (2/5) in the series-clinching 10-8 win...Struck out three batters against Albany (3/5).

2005: Played in 35 contests, starting 32...Saw majority of his time in left field and as a designated hitter...Hit .274 with seven doubles and a home run vs. UNCA (3/18)...Scored 24 runs and drove in 24...Third on the team with a .390 on-base percentage...Six of nine on stolen base attempts...Made only one error for a .970 fielding percentage...Made five relief appearances on the mound, allowing no earned runs in 6.2 innings of work, striking out four while walking only two.

Summer: Played in 43 contests for the Petersburg Generals of the Coastal Plain League...Had four dou-

bles and had five RBI...Also pitched in four games, striking out seven in 9.1 innings.

High School: First team all-district three straight years...Player-of-the-Year in the Central District...Played on the Central Team in the Commonwealth Games.

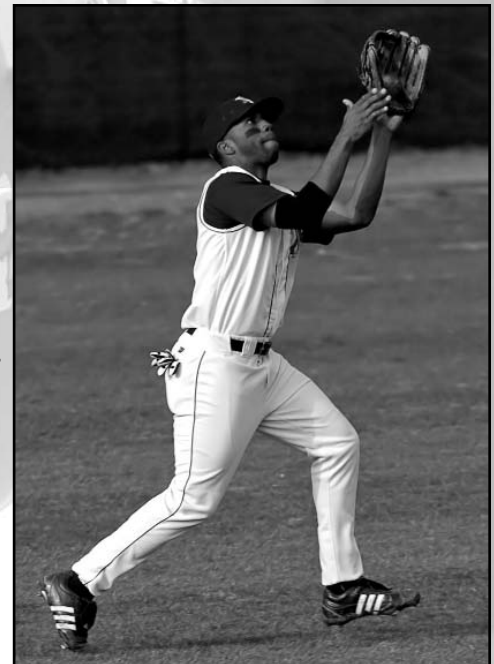

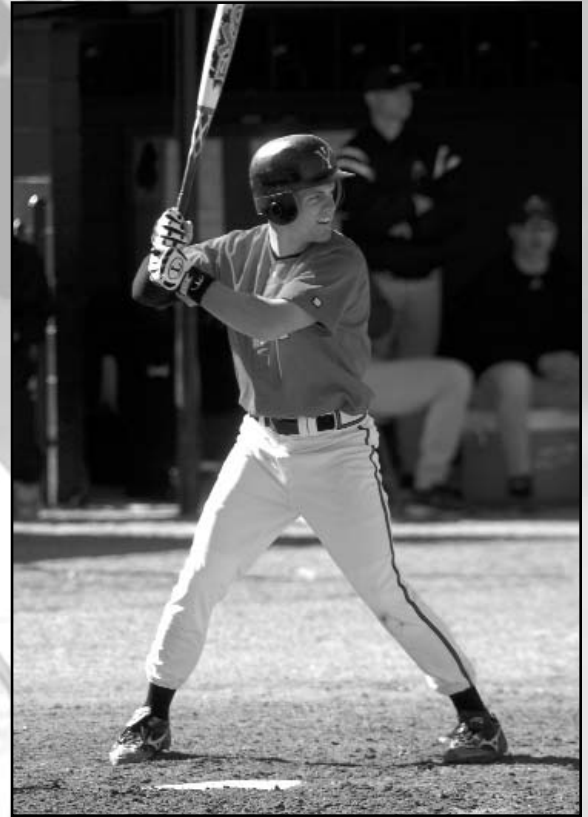
