



2006-07 Men's Season Outlook

Talent and youth are two words synonymous with the 2006-07 VMI men's track & field team. While most coaches might be concerned at the thought of seeing just five seniors on the roster, VMI head coach Mike Bozeman and his staff remains optimistic. Although nearly two-thirds of the men's team is comprised of freshman and sophomores, members of this year's team represent 54 of the 59 points scored at last season's indoor championships, and 33 of the 52 points scored at the outdoor championships.

Sprints, Relays & Hurdles:

The Keydets have an array of young and talented sprinters and hurdlers on this year's team, comprised mainly of freshman and sophomores, which make up arguably the team's deepest unit. Leading the charge once again this year will be IC4A qualifiers **Taili Evans** and **Jasper Watkins**. Evans, a sophomore, posted the conference's fifth best time in the 55m, however, focused mainly on the long jump & triple jump. Watkins, also a sophomore, was the Keydets most consistent performer in the 200m & 400m sprints, and will look to be the team's top scorer in those two events. Another recruit from the same class, **Hamid Abdurrahim**, was hampered last season due to injury but is back and will add depth to the sprinting unit.

Two-sport standout and sophomore **Joey Robinson** makes the transition from the football field to the track again this season, and returns as the team's top hurdler. Last season, Robinson finished second at the Indoor Championships (60m hurdles) and third at the Outdoor Championships (110m HH), and should be one of the Keydets top scorers again this season.

A trio of freshman will all have a shot to make an impact behind the bevy of sophomores at the front of the line. 2006 Timesland Track & Field recipient **Keith Gaines** will compete immediately for VMI in the hurdles and jumps. Gaines is the Virginia state outdoor champion in the 110m HH, while also finishing second in the 300m IH and third in the indoor 55m HH. Coach Bozeman also welcomes in a few more two-sport athletes to the unit, as **Zach Collins**, **Tim Maypray** and **Wilson Ileso** have all impressed the coaching staff and round out a talented group.

All members listed above have the experience or potential to make up the relay teams this year for VMI, which should also be one of the strongest teams in years. **Bryan Yerger**, an all-conference performer, returns for his senior season to push for the intermediate hurdles title, and will also be pressed by Abdurrahim.

Distance/Middle Distance:

The middle distance and distance corps continue to improve each season for the Keydets, and should once again contribute to the conference scoring. **Anthony Harris** and **Donnie Cowart** return this season as the top middle distance runners after coming off solid cross country seasons. After missing the indoor season, Harris responded with three-straight wins in the 800m, and scored for the team in both the 800m and 1500m at the conference championships. Cowart, who also redshirted the indoor season, will challenge Harris in the 800m and also lead the Keydets in the steeplechase. Also returning in the mid-distance are **Mark Bush**, **Ben Switzer**, **Cory Houck** and **Jared Klajnbart**, all of which look to play important roles this season, along with newcomers **Garland Gray** and **T.J. Laird**. Also look for freshmen **Andrew Rademaker** (R-Fr.), **Matt Sagar** and **Matt Satterwhite** to contribute in the steeplechase.

The nucleus of runners in the 3k, 5k and 10k events return this season, and feature more depth than in years past. **Graham Forbes**, **Kurt Able** and **Patrick Eggleston** bring experience to the unit after scoring at the conference championships in their respective events the past two seasons. Also look for Rademaker, junior **Kevin Sullivan** and freshman **Jonathan Buckland** to contend for top spots at the conference championships.

Jumps & Throws:

The horizontal jumps took a big loss this past season with the graduation of Big South and IC4A high jump champion Garrett Brickner. However, junior **Chi Chi Ezekwe** showed improvement last season and should be the team's top jumper in the event. The long jump and triple jump will be a logjam of talented candidates, headed by 2006 Big South Indoor Champion Evans. Providing competition for Evans in the long and triple jump will be junior **Chris Alderman**, as well as Gaines, Robinson, Ezekwe, Collins and Ileso.

Tyler Tucker had a solid freshman season in the pole vault, and showed his versatility by finishing second in both the heptathlon and decathlon in the conference championships. The throwing units might be the most inexperienced group on the team, but has gained some good talent this season. Heading the throws will be junior **Tim Beckley**, who will compete in the shot put and weight throw, followed by sophomore **Sean Thompson**. In the Javelin, it will certainly be tough to replace VMI record holder Chris Brandriff, but sophomore **Bridger Hodson** has shown continued improvement in the event.
