VMI BASEBALL WRAP-UP

The VMI Keydets, operating under 1st year haed coach Vern Beitzel, did not have a highly successful season, if only the win-loss columns are looked at. In conference play, the Keydets were only 2-12, picking up their victories in double-header splits with Appalachian State and with Furman. Out of the conference, VMI was 3-7, defeating Liberty Baptist in both ends of a double-header and defeating Old Dominion in a single game.

Although the team did not win many games, there were some excellent individual and team performances to be found. On the season, the team hit .266 and had a slugging average of .387 (708 ABs, 188 hits, 274 TBs), both of which are the third highest in VMI Baseball history. The team scored 113 runs for the third highest run production in Keydet history. To top everything off team-wise, the Keydets set a new season homerun record by knocking 16 balls over the fence. The old record of 15 had been set in 1963, when the team hit .294, for the highest team average ever.

Individually, there were also several excellent performances. Topping the list would have to be Scott Snow. Snow hit 6 of the team's 16 homers, to set a new individual season record, breaking the old record of 4, that was set in 1951 and tied in 1963. Kelly Lombard also came on strong at the plate, hitting 4 pitches out to tie the old record of 4 homers. With two more seasons left to play, Lombard could very well end up the all-time leading homerun hitter for the Keydets.

In view of the outstanding individual performances and the team effort put forth, we are asking that the men listed on the following page be given consideration for All-Conference honoes.

KELLY LOMBARD 61 ABs, 2i Hs, 3 2Bs, 4 HRs ... hit for an average of .344 to lead all regulars ... slugging average of .590 ... second on the team in homers ... third on the team in runs scored with 15 ... led the team in RBIs with 19 ... reached base 43% of the time, batting in the top five of the batting order for much of the season ... played in 22 of the team's games, starting 17 of them ... served in several roles for the Keydets; catcher, DH, and left fielder ... committed only 3 errors behind the plate and in left field ... an extremely versatile player who has also appeared at Thirdbase and at shortstop on one occasion each this year.

RUSSELL PUCKETT 82 ABs, 27 Hs, 5 2Bs, 1 3B, 1 HR ... hit for an average of .329 ... slugging average of .451 ... second on the team in runs scored with 16 ... fourth on the team in RBIs with 10 ... reached base 44% of the time, batting in the clean-up spot of the order for the entire season ... starting center fielder in all 24 of the Keydet's games ... committed only 3 errors in 80 chances, while making many run saving catches ... has thrown out 6 runners trying to advance after tagging up ... has two of the Keydet's eight stolen bases ... a hustling player who is capable of stretching a single into a double ... a constant threat at the plate of hitting the long ball.
