ONE-YEAR LETTERMAN - The 2001 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year...was not eligible to play last year because of academics and took a redshirt year...an explosive, big play performer who can make things happen when he touches the ball...should give the offense added versatility...swung back into action with a productive spring capped by an outstanding 2003 spring game when he rushed nine times for 79 yards and a touchdown (10-yard run)...will be counted on heavily as both a running back and receiver out of the backfield...very fast, quick, and explosive...has all-conference capability...worked hard during the past year and matured in his overall development as a player...projected as a starter at one slotback position...also an outstanding track performer.

2001 - Named the 2001 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year by the league coaches...became the first VMI player to win the award since receiver Marlon Anderson in 1992...capped his debut season by setting a school record in kick return yardage in a season (surpassed since by Kevin Solomon's 750 yards last year) and averaged 24.4 yards which ranked third in the SoCon and 29th nationally...played in 10 games and made three starts at slotback...led VMI freshmen in receiving with 20 catches for 157 yards...ranked sixth on the team in receptions...also rushed four times for nine yards and a touchdown...completed a pass for 39 yards vs. GSU...named SoCon Freshman of the Week for his play against top-ranked Georgia Southern when he returned four kickoffs for 126 yards including a long of 50 yards and also caught five passes for 21 yards...became VMI's first player to win Freshman of the Week honors since Matt Kluk in 1999...returned six kickoffs for 207 yards against Furman including returns of 53, 48, and 42 yards and the 207 return yards mark was then the second most in a game in Southern Conference history.

HIGH SCHOOL - A three-time all-conference selection at LaPlata (Md.) High School...named all-conference three times at defensive back and once at running back...rushed for over 1,000 yards each of the last two years...intercepted seven passes for his career and returned four for touchdowns...lettered once in indoor track and placed second in the 55-meter dash.
